PREFACE



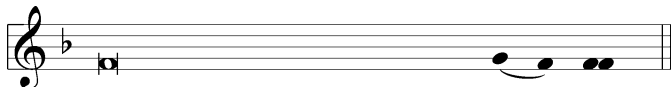

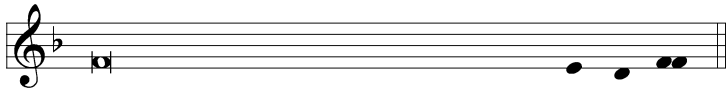
