Just because we celebrated Easter morning does not mean our Easter celebration and Easter joy is over. Indeed, we worship on Sunday because every Sunday is an Easter celebration for us Christians. Our Divine Service follows the Church year events to proclaim what we believe,

teach and confess. It is also wherein we are gathered to be given the gifts of God so that we are filled so that we might be strengthened to live lives of faith always being ready to give an answer for our hope and joy in Jesus. Remember, when we come to the Lord's Table we are gathered there with the company of heavenly hosts, all the saints who have gone on before us. And do not worry, you will not be put on the spot to read, to answer a question, or what not, but you will have the opportunity if you wish and volunteer to read and ask questions.

Lastly, let me encourage you to attend the regular, quarterly meeting of the Texas Confessional Lutherans which will be meeting on April 18 at Grace Lutheran Church, Brenham, Texas. I am not sure what our topic will be so watch the bulletin for more information. We have these meetings to encourage each other as confessional brothers and sisters.




Sunday Adult Bible Classes


