

Biographical notes


Mark "Marcos" Kempff was born in Guatemala, grew up in Central America (Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras). A fourth-generation missionary, with a family heritage including several cultures. Completed undergraduate, DCE and graduate studies at Concordia, Seward (1974, 1986 and 1996). Served as a LCMS educational missionary in Latin America for 33 years: Venezuela (1975-2003) and Panama (2003-2008), as a DCE, theological education program developer, professor, church planter and theological education network facilitator. Traveled extensively throughout Latin America.

Served as Production Manager for *Cristo Para Todas Las Naciones* (Venezuelan ILLL Office) and author of 50+ thematic follow-up evangelistic booklets and resources (1986-1993). After serving with the Center for Hispanic Studies of Concordia Seminary, St. Louis (from August 2008-November 2022), he retired as instructor, curriculum developer and administrative assistant, primarily in the Spanish language.

He wishes to remain involved in continuing education courses, including ministering among the Hispanic-Latino communities, retreats and workshops on Hispanic-Latino marriage and family issues. He continues to serve as member of the editorial committee of Lutheran Mission Matters, St. Louis. He also collaborates as writer for Lutheran Hour Ministries-*Cristo Para Todas Las Naciones - Para el camino*, St. Louis.

His wife of almost 33 years, Ruth Rivero, of Venezuelan nationality, died of cancer in March 2011. Daughter Raquel, married to Álvaro, live in Dallas, Texas, with their children, Isabella and Sebastian; and daughter Rebeca, recently engaged, lives in Lincoln, Nebraska.
