The Pentecost, non-festival portion of our Church Year, which is the bulk of our Church Year, some 26 Sundays is the time we use to grow in our Christian faith and life, thus the liturgical color of green.

It is my prayer and encouragement that, as the world strives to get back to "normal" with all that has been going on, we all seek to get back to our regular routine of being in the Lord's House every Sunday for Divine Service.
