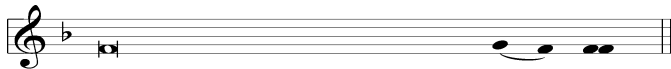


## THE WORDS OF OUR LORD

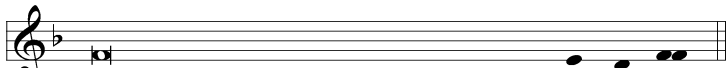
