**Color of the Day:** Red - is associated with blood and fire, the latter reminiscent of the Spirit's presence at Pentecost, red is used for Pentecost and for the days dedicated to martyrs. It is also used for festivals of renewal in the Holy Spirit - such as Reformation and missions - and often for ordination rites as well as ordination and installation anniversaries.

<sup>19</sup> Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under
the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be
held accountable to God. <sup>20</sup> For by works of the law no human being will be
justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.
<sup>21</sup> But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the
law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it— <sup>22</sup> the
righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For
there is no distinction: <sup>23</sup> for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of
