Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The month of November is often referred to as the month our Holiday season begins. Remember Jesus' words, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up" (John 2:19). The Church is the body of Christ, that is, those who have faith in Jesus and Jesus alone for salvation.

As the "holiday" season begins anew, I would encourage you, by the power of the Holy Spirit, to renew your zeal and thanksgiving to God and your desire to make regular and diligent us of His means of grace, attending as many if not all the extra opportunities that will be offered to be in Divine Service and Bible Class, to be given the gifts and blessings God has to give.
