

- Please pray for the new baby Prince who arrived just yesterday. We aren't sure if we will keep that name, but maybe! Wink. He also comes from a very sad situation of which I will not give to many details, but his mother abandoned him and the family. Then the father and his mother (the baby's grandmother) committed suicide.
- Please pray for Lucy, our new 3-year-old girl. She was defiled by her father and who has a mother that is mentally ill. Pray that we can minister to her and bring healing to this little innocent girl. Lillian has reported that she is doing much better after only a week with us. I give God the glory for the answered prayers for her, but she still needs a lot of healing.
- ✤ Continue to pray for the other new children: George 7 years old, the twins David and Daniel, Baby Paul and Baby Jane. They are all improving so much.
- All of our children are now at home for two months. Our staff really needs prayers for strength and patience as this is a very long time to have that many children along with the new babies we have received.
- ➡ Please pray for the Lord to send us a gifted servant to work alongside our team here in the US as our Director of Operations.
- ✤ Continue to pray that our children continue to grow in the Lord and respect the staff that is caring for them.
- ✤ Pray for us to find a new house to rent for our Woodsedge Home for our young adults that are soon graduating from high school and will attend universities and technical schools in the city. We will have 20 students that need to live in the home in the next few years, so we need a larger home to house them.
- Paul, my husband, and I will be leaving for Kenya this Friday. Please pray for safety and strength, and for us to be able to accomplish all that God has for us while we are there. I'm so excited to meet all our new children.
