Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The month of August brings the beginning of the end and the beginning of the beginning. August brings the end of the Summer months especially as Summer is traditionally the time for vacations and for our children to have a respite from school. August brings the beginning of a new school year and thus the beginning of new programs and adventures.

Yet, for us in the church, our Church Year continues as we continue in the midst of our Pentecost season. The season of the Church Year is marked by the liturgical color of green, the color of growth reminding us that we are to daily and weekly grow in our Christian faith and life. We do this through our making regular and diligent use of the means of grace, the Word and Sacraments.

As you hear me say continually, we get it right when we point to Jesus. Indeed, our whole life is to be a life pointing to Jesus. Our week begins with Divine Service wherein we are lavished with the good gifts and blessings our Lord gives to us, again through Word and Sacrament. We need these gifts from God so that we may face the week that is ahead of us. And we need the constant reminder that our Divine Service is just that A Divine, a God service, first and foremost to us. Our Sunday morning service is not our coming together to do something for God. It is not our entertaining God nor our being entertained. Nothing gets in the way of the cross of Christ.

God is the prime mover. God gives, and we are given to. From the Divine Service we are moved to respond. Our response of faith is just that, a response. God gives. There is nothing that He needs from us. We are the ones who need from Him. God does not need our prayers, our praise, our offerings, our anything. We need to pray, not because God does not know what we need, but because He desires that we recognize and acknowledge our need. God does not need our praise, indeed, just as Jesus entered Jerusalem and "the very stones would have praised Him," so our praise is simply a response of thanks. God does not need our offerings (although the earthly institution of the church does in order to operate), we need to bring our first fruits and tithes as a response of faith, a response of thanksgiving for what God first gives to us (through the gifts, talents, abilities, job and career He has given to us to be able to earn a living), and a response of faith that He will continue to bless us.

As we move forward especially into the Fall, our nomination committee will be seeking people to serve in our congregation. Please give thought to how you might serve. Has God given you certain gifts, talents and abilities which might serve well on any particular board (Elders, Education, Evangelism, Stewardship, Trustees)? I would ask that you prayerfully give thought to stepping up to serve. Remember, we serve God by serving others, especially in our vocations, but also in our congregation. If you are not sure where you might be able to serve best, talk to me, I am sure we can find a place where you might be able to respond to all that God has given in use of what He has given to you.
